AMC 2013

6TH ASIAN MATHEMATICAL CONFERENCE BEXCO, Busan, Korea June 30 (Sun) - July 4 (Thu), 2013 http://www.kms.kr/amc2013

We are pleased to announce that the 6TH ASIAN MATHEMATICAL CONFERENCE will take place in Busan, Korea, from June 30 through July 4, 2013. All mathematical programs and side events will be held at BEXCO (Busan Exhibition and Convention Center), which is located in the large "Centum city" complex in Busan. Situated on the southeastern tip of Korea, Busan is its largest port city. From rolling hills and fresh seafood markets to endless beaches and picturesque islands, Busan is one of Korea's most beautiful and captivating cities.

The AMC series is a major SEAMS(South East Asian Mathematical Society) conference, held every 4-5 years since 1990, and hosted by countries in Southeast Asia. The First AMC was held in Hong Kong (1990), the Second in Thailand (1995), the Third in the Philippines (2000), the Fourth in Singapore (2005), and the latest was Malaysia (2009). In 2013, it will be held in Korea as a joint meeting with Korean Mathematical Society (KMS) Spring Meeting. It is the first time in its history that the AMC to be hosted in East Asia.

AMC 2013 is co-hosted by KMS (Korean Mathematical Society) and SEAMS (Southeast Asian Mathematical Society) in collaboration with the Organizing Committee for the International Congress of Mathematicians 2014 (Seoul ICM 2014). The objective of the conference is to provide a forum for mathematics researchers from Asia to foster links and collaboration among themselves and with mathematicians from other parts of the world through the discussion of issues, exchange of ideas and the presentation of research findings. Also, a forum on the future of Asian Mathematics will be organized during the conference.

The organizers of the AMC 2013 stand ready to provide all possible support for a successful conference and hope many members of MSJ can come and enjoy this event. It is our pleasure to announce that the AMC 2013 website (http://www.kms.kr/amc2013/) has officially opened where you are welcome to pre-register for the conference.

There will be eight one-hour Plenary Lectures covering recent developments in the mathematics and dozens of forty-five-minute Invited Lectures in parallel sections among the fifteen special sessions. AMC 2013 Plenary Speakers are Seung Yeal HA (Seoul National University, Korea), Minhyong KIM (University of Oxford, UK & POSTECH, Korea), Takuro MOCHIZUKI (RIMS, Kyoto University, Japan), Bao Chau NGO (University of Chicago, USA & VIASM, Vietnam), Shige PENG (Shandong University, China), Takeshi SAITO (University of Tokyo, Japan), Zuowei SHEN (National University of Singapore, Singapore), and Gang TIAN (Peking University, China & Princeton University, USA).

Every registered participant of the conference will have the opportunity to give a short presentation, either during a poster session or in the form of a contributed talk, with acceptance at the discretion of the organizers. Participants interested in presenting contributed talks or posters are requested to submit their abstracts in electronic form through online submission system before February 20 (Wed), 2013. Abstracts must be written in English and typed using LaTeX. The official language of the conference is English, therefore, all abstracts, posters and oral presentations must be in English.
